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Greetings From The WAY Team,

Can you believe it? The WAY Center officially turned the big "20" this year as a nonprofit organization. To God be the glory, great things He has done! This past March, The WAY Center Founder, Cindy Gallucci, and many friends from the community came together for an open house celebration at The WAY Home. It was a joyful experience as we reminisced about all the miracles that have happened since Cindy started handing out clothes to women from her garage back in 2002. It took several months of planning and hard work by Cindy and the Board to finally achieve our 501 (C) (3) status in 2003. A tiny seed of faith was planted in hopes of what we see today. Cindy was overjoyed to serve at The WAY Home during her visit while our house manager was recovering from hip displacement. The timing of Cindy's visit was yet another miracle of God's provision in a time of need.

In the past 20 years we have outgrown four prior locations and are again bursting at the seams in our current location that houses The WAY Center and WAY 2 Shoppe. Our services have morphed from handing out food, clothing, and household items, to being able to provide classes, workshops and support groups that act as a catalyst for major life transformation in the families we serve. We have also been able to prevent homelessness for many families by providing emergency lodging, rental assistance, transitional housing, and transportation assistance to nearby shelters or to family members.

The WAY Home, which was established in 2011, has housed over 40 women and their children who desired to "break the cycle" of chaos and homelessness in their lives.

Residents must commit to a minimum of 6 months in the transitional housing program in an effort to establish healthy boundaries, understand the value of healthy relationships, and gain the skills and resources necessary to live independently with little to no government assistance. It generally takes 12-18 months to complete all programs offered by The WAY Center.

Our Mission is to provide a variety of spiritual and social services for families in need or

**crisis.** Our desire is to work with these families for a period of time to help them overcome obstacles that keep them from meeting personal, financial and spiritual goals. We do this by offering a variety of programs strategically designed to help people transition from crisis mode (which is often filled with uncertainty, frustration, and chaos) to a place of confidence, peace and stability.



**Crisis Care** assists individuals and families with immediate needs due to unforeseen circumstances or difficult life challenges. This could be caused by a loss of income, unexpected expense, or other type of tragedy. We offer food, clothing, gas cards, financial assistance, hygiene items, diapers, wipes and other tangible resources from our thrift store. We also offer HOPE, support, prayer, direction and referrals to other organizations that may be able to meet any special needs outside our scope of service.

WAY 2 Thrive is a 4-6 month program providing case management, mentoring, biblical counseling, and group support. This comprehensive program is specially designed to help individuals improve their overall health and emotional well-being. This leads to a healthier sense of self, healthier relationships, and therefore healthier communities.



WAY 2 Work focuses on goal setting, time management, educational growth, money management, employability skills, and vocational planning that lead to gainful employment or workplace advancement and self-sufficiency. Services offered through this program include case management with a team advisor who helps participants develop an action plan, budgeting, and provides accountability. We also assist with transportation, work experience, and financial assistance as it relates to obtaining and maintaining employment.

In addition to all this we are able to offer furniture, clothing, and household items to the whole community at affordable prices.
